

## Easy DIY Bird Feeder



### Supplies needed:

- Cardboard tube (like a clean toilet roll)
- Peanut butter or honey
- Birdseed
- String or yarn
- Scissors
- Butter knife ( popsicle stick
- Tray or dish
- Bamboo skewer (optional)

### Prep:

1. Get your supplies together in one place.
2. Pour your birdseed into your tray or dish and set aside.

### Let's get making!

#### Step 1:

Using your scissors or bamboo skewer, poke a hole on each side of both ends of the toilet paper roll.

#### Step 2:

Using your butter knife or popsicle stick, spread the peanut butter or honey all over the toilet paper roll. Don't have a butter knife or popsicle stick? Get messy and use your fingers!

**Step 3:**

Roll your toilet paper roll on the dish of birdseed, making sure to thoroughly cover it in seeds.

**Step 4:**

Put your bamboo skewer through the set of holes on one end of the roll.

**Step 5:**

Measure out your string or yarn (about 6 or 8 inches will work). Carefully thread it through the holes on the other end of the roll and tie a knot to make a loop.

**Step 6:**

Hang your bird feeder in a tree and wait to see the birds arrive!
